C. The College has received a grant from SUNY for the development and launch of a Trades Program which includes education and training in the HVAC, Welding and Electrical fields. This initiative aims to equip high school graduates and adult learners with the skills needed to thrive in today's competitive job market, and bridge the gap between education and employment, providing a vital resource for individuals and businesses. It is anticipated that these programs will launch in September 2025. The grant provides funding in the amount of \$150,000 to promote and market these programs. The College has an existing contract with ZE Creative which was executed on April 8, 2024. The services under this agreement include, but are not limited to, the delivery of strategic communications through public relations outreach to local and regional sources, crisis management, media training, liaise with community groups, prepare newsletters and specialty publications, develop advertising campaigns, videography, manage social media and website development and maintenance. The College has elected to amend this agreement to include additional services to promote and market the Trades Program.

**RESOLVED,** that the pending Contract Amendment with ZE Creative in the additional annual amount of \$150,000 for a total annual amount of \$198,000, as requested by Joseph Jankowski, Acting Vice President for Institutional Advancement, is approved by the Nassau Community College Board of Trustees Finance and Capital Committee and will be recommended to the full Board of Trustees for approval.
