WHEREAS, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS MIGUEL OTERO, JULIO PEREZ, CHARLES DITTMAR AND JUSTIN BOLOBANIC HAVE ALL MET THE QUALIFICATIONS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE APPOINTMENT OF MIGUEL OTERO, JULIO PEREZ, CHARLES DITTMAR AND JUSTIN BOLOBANIC AS PEACE OFFICERS EFFECTIVE APRIL 9, 2018, AND BE IT

FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY AUTHORIZES PRESIDENT W. HUBERT KEEN TO ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION.
