FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT DR. W. HUBERT KEEN, PRESIDENT OF NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE, BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE THE FORMAL COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE, AND BE IT

WHEREAS, IN JANUARY 2017 THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVED QUALIFICATIONS FOR A CAMPUS SECURITY OFFICER TO BE DESIGNATED AS A PEACE OFFICER, AND

WHEREAS, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS KEITH BLUM AND CHRISTOPHER WOOD HAVE BOTH MET THE QUALIFICATIONS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE APPOINTMENT OF KEITH BLUM AND CHRISTOPHER WOOD AS PEACE OFFICERS RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1, 2017, AND BE IT

FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HEREBY AUTHORIZES PRESIDENT W. HUBERT KEEN TO ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION.
