Chair Powers requested a motion pursuant to Section 105 of the Open Meetings Law of the State of New York that the Personnel, Affirmative Action and Labor Committee go into Executive Session for reviewing the medical, financial, credit or employment history of a particular person or corporation, or matters leading to the appointment, employment, promotion, demotion, discipline, suspension, dismissal or removal of a particular person or corporation. Trustee Green moved the motion; seconded by Trustee DeGrace. Motion carried 3-0.

The meeting resumed at 6:20 p.m.

3. Chair Powers introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE ADMINISTRATORS' ASSOCIATION (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE "ASSOCIATION") FILED A CERTIFICATION PETITION BEFORE THE NEW YORK STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS BOARD (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS "PERB") DATED JUNE 29, 2016, SEEKING THE INCLUSION OF SEVENTY-FIVE (75) TITLES IN THE PROPOSED BARGAINING UNIT; AND,

WHEREAS, THE PARTIES REACHED AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO SIXTY-NINE (69) OF THE PROPOSED UNIT MEMBERS BY STIPULATION DATED DECEMBER 14, 2016, WITH FORTY-SIX (46) TITLES BEING INCLUDED IN THE PROPOSED BARGAINING UNIT AND TWENTY-THREE (23) TITLES BEING EXCLUDED; AND,

WHEREAS, ON JANUARY 24, 2017, PERB CERTIFIED THE ASSOCIATION AS THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATIONS AND SETTLEMENT OF GRIEVANCES FOR ONLY THOSE TITLES INCLUDED IN THE BARGAINING UNIT AS STIPULATED TO IN THE DECEMBER 14, 2016 STIPULATION, LEAVING SIX (6) TITLES AT-ISSUE, NAMELY, THOSE EMPLOYEES WHO PERFORM SERVICES FOR THE NCC FOUNDATION; AND,

WHEREAS, THE PARTIES HAVE NOW REACHED A STIPULATION WITH RESPECT TO THE REMAINING SIX (6) AT-ISSUE TITLES AND THEIR INCUMBENTS WHO PERFORM SERVICES FOR THE NCC FOUNDATION;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE HEREWITH APPROVES AND RATIFIES THE STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT DATED JANUARY 9, 2018 BETWEEN THE NEGOTIATING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE ADMINISTRATORS ASSOCIATION AND THE NEGOTIATING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NASSAU COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

Chair Powers asked if there were any comments. There being none, he requested a motion to forward this resolution to the Board of Trustees for approval. Trustee Green made the motion; seconded by Trustee DeGrace. Motion carried 4-0.

Chair Powers asked if there were any other items for the Committee to consider. There being none, the meeting adjourned at 6:22 p.m.
