Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee Meeting Minutes

May 14, 2024

The meeting of the Academic, Student Affairs & Enrollment Committee of the Board of Trustees was held on the eleventh floor of the Administrative Tower. The meeting was called to order by Chair Tuman at 5:25 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes

Trustee Tuman requested a motion to approve the minutes of April 9, 2024. Trustee Weiss moved the motion; seconded by Trustee D'Agostino. Motion carried 4-0.

2. Enrollment Updates

Registrar Barkan presented the Summer 2024 report comparing May 9, 2024 to May 11, 2023, which reveals an increase of 2.14%. Summer enrollment applications are down, however registered students are up for non-degree and visiting students. Fall registration shows an increase of 22.54% in credits and 20.10% in head count. The Registrar's office continues its outreach to attract students for the summer and fall with mailings to new, continuing students and new non-degree and visiting students.

Asst. VP Follick presented the Fall new student enrollment trends comparing May 7, 2024 to May 7, 2023 showing a slight decrease in first-year applications but an increase in registered students. Transfer applications are up, which is the normal trend. Roughly, 471 students have been tested as of May 6, 2024, compared to 949 students from Fall 2023, with testing on campus as the preferred modality. NCC hosted New Admitted Students' Day, held on April 24th and 26th, which was attended by over a hundred students each day. He thanked all involved for the success of the events. Student Activities office will be hosting new student orientation days in August.

Chair Tuman asked if there were any other items for the Committee to consider. There being none, the meeting adjourned at 5:31p.m.
