

Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation Rates

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965 (as amended) requires all institutions receiving Title IV funding to disclose graduation/completion rates and, if applicable, transfer-out rates of the general student body. The following information reflects retention, graduation and transfer-out rates of all new, first-time, full-time degree-seeking students and new, first-time, full-time degree-seeking student athletes.

Key definitions associated with this report include:

- Retention rate: The percentage of new, first-time, full-time degree-seeking students who enrolled from Fall to Fall.
- Graduation rate: The percentage of new, first-time, full-time degree-seeking students completing their program within a specific time period. For example: 2-years (100%; normal completion time), 3-years (150%; one and one-half times normal completion time)
- Transfer-out: The percentage of new, first-time, full-time degree-seeking students who transfer to another higher education institution within the first 3-years (150%) of starting semester.
