Submit Educational Documents:

"In the case of secondary education, please be aware that NCC reserves the right to request an applicant complete a third-party credential evaluation for academic documents from outside of the Unites States. The evaluation company must be members of NACES, AICE".

Post –Secondary Education: Scan and submit official U.S college/U.S university transcripts in a sealed envelope. For foreign college/university transcripts, students are **required** to submit a course by course evaluation. The evaluation results may be sent directly to our office by the credential evaluation service or may be brought to our office in person in a sealed envelope.
