THE FIVE (5) W's IN AN EMERGENCY

Lock down and Shelter-in-Place both involve taking refuge in a pre-designated room until the emergency situation is resolved.



WHO IS IMPACTED...

The entire campus community

The entire campus community

WHAT TO DO...

Locks, Lights, Out of Sight

Remain Calm; Mute Cell Phones; Remain Quiet.

The Hide in

RUN.HIDE.FIGHT

Do not leave until the ALL CLEAR is received.

Get inside. Lock Outside Doors.

Pause your class. Stay in your classroom or area. Clear Halls
Remain Calm

Do not leave until the ALL CLEAR is received.

WHEN TO FOLLOW PROCEDURE...

Immediate physical threat on campus
For instance, the presence of a hostile or armed intruder on Campus

Certain situations such as:
Weather emergencies
Environmental hazards
Local emergencies [such as nearby police activity]

WHERE TO GO...

Move away from danger
If outside, seek cover in nearest building
Lock doors and barricade entry to classroom, office, or interior room. Stay away from windows

Use a structure to separate you from the hazard
Take immediate shelter in nearest building
Close exterior doors

WHY LOCKDOWN OR SHELTER-IN-PLACE...

The purpose is to lock down campus and have community members in a secure place while law enforcement clears the threat.

The purpose is to keep the community safe and avoid the hazard, while keeping campus paths clear for emergency use.
